ACHIEVING RESULTS FOR WOODFORD

I am delighted to see the improvements that have been made in Woodford and the surrounding community and am very pleased that I have been able to assist the community in my role as Minister for Rural Affairs and TD for Galway East. I want to acknowledge the voluntary work of all organisations in bringing about these improvements, which are so important to the local community.



Recently the village has received:

- €100,000 from my Department under the Town and Village Renewal Scheme to replace footpaths
- €80,000 from my Department under the Rural Regeneration Fund for Derrycrag Nature Trail
- €31,300 for the astro pitch and lighting for Tommy Larkins GAA under Sports Capital Grants
- €23,400 for a storm water collection system at Rossmore from the Office of Public Works
- Funding for rehabilitation work at Bolagh Bridge
- Funding for the Woodford Furnace Festival under the Small Scale Local Festivals and Summer Schools Fund
